Job Description: Primarily responsible for organizing and carrying out structured learning processes for students in the Commercial Truck Driving program. In addition, instructors participate in the full range of professional and college-related activities including student advising, curriculum development, professional growth, departmental and community involvement. Reports directly to the Regional Workforce Coordinator.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Plans and teaches Commercial Truck Driving classes and practicum/lab work as assigned.
2. Develops, implements, and evaluates student classroom/lab work learning activities.
3. Provides a positive role model for the students, especially in areas of caring, advocacy, respect for self and others, collegiality, ethical behavior, ethical reasoning, and strong work ethic (including responsibility, dependability, and accountability) and provides constructive feedback to students.
4. Provides direct supervision and evaluation of students as they perform in lab as scheduled.
5. Provides individual performance review and recommendations to students as needed; completes weekly evaluation on each student in lab setting, and formally discusses and documents evaluations with students at least once per training session.
