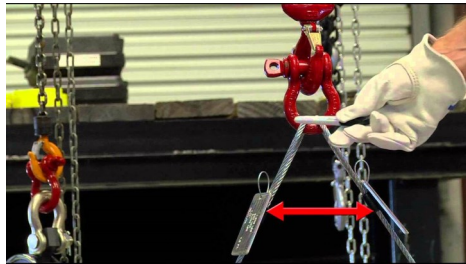




LAND-BASED ENERGY OPERATIONS BASIC RIGGING CLASS

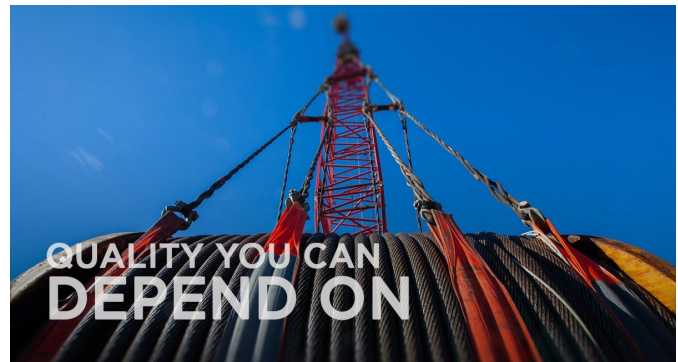

This course provides an extra emphasis on ASME (American Society of Mechanical Engineers) and API (American Petroleum Institute) information coupled with well servicing, gin pole truck and energy industry specifics.

This course is designed to provide the attendee with the BASIC knowledge and skills to identify unsafe conditions while using Crosby rigging hardware with wire rope, chain and synthetic slings.
