

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Position: Advising Specialist (five (5) year grant term)

Job Description: Southwest Mississippi Community College has an opening for an Advising Specialist for the PBI Grant. The position will assist and support the delivery of SMCC's Academic Advising efforts by providing training for academic coaches and developing and administering academic coaching procedures for the Student Academic Support Center. The position will also collaborate with the appropriate College departments and resources to help develop faculty and student support services. The successful candidate will be a team-oriented professional who is willing to learn and participate in a collaborative setting under the direction of the Title III PBI Grant Administrator and other administrators. This position reports to the Title III PBI Grant Administrator.

Duties and Responsibilities: Include but are not limited to:

- Under PBI Director, manage and administer all aspects of the PBI activity related to advising and student support.
- Design, manage Coaching program, collaborating with the Success Center Coordinator
- Establish and maintain effective strategies to promote the success of Black male students in a manner consistent with the objectives and developmental advising rationale.
- Train and evaluate Academic Coaches.
- Assist with evaluation of advising processes and retention, degree completion outcomes.
- Organize and implement professional development for Academic Coaches in advising strategies, including supporting technologies.
- Participate in conferences and webinars focusing on best practices in advising.

Qualifications & Experience:
