Position: Head Resident - Men's Residence Hall Alford Conerly

Job Description: Southwest Mississippi Community College has an opening for a Head Men's Resident in the Alford Conerly Hall. The head residents are student advocates who reside within and administer the residence halls. Head Residents administer the units: Check-in and Check-out, maintenance and housekeeping reporting, enforcing regulations and facilitating activities. The Head Resident reports directly to the Director of Student Activities and Housing.

Duties and Responsibilities: Include but are not limited to:

- Will reside on campus in the residence hall apartment.
- Will always be available/in contact with the Director of Student Activities and Housing either by phone in the resident hall, email, or cell phone. The head resident maintains a good working relationship with housekeeping, campus police, housing, and the office of the Vice-President for Student Affairs.
- Communicates with all residents to establish friendly relations
- Will make their presence known and be in residence hall, during night time hours and should be available during weekends. The employee should remain in the residence hall and respond as directed during times of crisis e.g. hurricanes, tropical storms etc.
- Conducts inspections each week to make sure rooms are clean
- Responsible for submitting maintenance/housekeeping request forms

Qualifications & Experience:
