GED Test Battery:

Total time allowed for testing is as follows:

Test Name	Time Limit
Reasoning Through Lang Arts	150 minutes
Mathematical Reasoning	115 minutes
Science	90 minutes
Social Studies	90 minutes

An individual may test up to three times per content area with no wait. There are 7 different item types:

- Extended response
- Drag- and- drop
- Drop-down
- Fill-in –the-blank
- Hot spot
- Multiple Choice
- Short answer

Cost:

The GED per subject area test fee is \$30.00 with two discounted retakes.

Debit, Credit and Gift Cards are accepted via the online system and emails the receipt directly to the purchaser.

Other Information

- Tests are delivered on computer (not online).
- Same-day scoring on all four parts including the new score report for reporting and remediation
- A passing score range is 150-200 per exam. Two score levels are offered:
 - o GED® Passing Score: at or higher than the minimum needed to demonstrate high school equivalency-level skills and abilities
 - o GED® Passing Score with Honors: at or higher than the minimum needed to demonstrate career- and college-readiness (CCR)
